- Represents academic and related staff across the UK
- Works to support members' rights and interests
- Joining gives you access to Union resources, advice and representation
- Membership is free for PGRs who are not contracted to teach (Student membership)
- PGRs who are contracted to teach can upgrade to a full (Standard Free) membership, which is free for 12 months and based on a small subscription thereafter.

Wins



- For mathematics PGRs at Edinburgh, teaching contracts are now 4 years, rather than 1
- In the wider university at Edinburgh, formalised a ban on unpaid teaching being a part of scholarships
- Nationally, lobbied for a 10% increase of UKRI stipend rate in 2022
